

## **PAI AWARDS**

## **EXCELLENCE IN JOURNALISM**

#### 1. SPOT NEWS REPORTING

This category honors the publication that does the best job of first-day coverage of a one-time event on a deadline.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- General community importance
- Alertness or quick action
- Exclusivity of unique angles developed
- Quality of final news product

#### 2. EDITORIAL FEATURE

This category honors an outstanding single, one-time feature story. Entries can either be soft news of human interest or can delve into significant community problems.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Degree of reader interest
- · Quality of finished product
- Exclusivity or unique angle developed

#### 3. EDITORIAL ENTERPRISE REPORTING

This category honors a publication breaking a story, regardless of the publication schedule.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- The publication must have broken the story
- The story should have a compelling public interest
- The story must be proactive
- Exclusivity or unique angle developed

#### 4. EDITORIAL SERIES

This category honors multi-part efforts, which examine some aspects of the community, its people, its problems, its needs, its successes and its failures. Entries must consist of at least two articles or stories from different issues.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Degree of community service
- Quality of finished product
- Exclusivity or unique angles developed

#### **5. EDITORIAL OPINION**

This category honors a publication that produces the best single editorial dealing with any subject. This award is intended to encourage publications to take stands and express opinions on issues affecting their community, state or nation.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- General excellence
- Degree of reader interest
- Unique angle developed

### 6. EDITORIAL COLUMN DEPARTMENT

This category honors an outstanding, regularly appearing column and/or department by a single writer. Submit three samples, two of which must have been consecutively published.

- Quality of finished product

#### 7. INVESTIGATIVE REPORTING

This category honors investigative reporting by a reporter or reporting team. Entries may be a single article or series of no more than 10 articles, which may include sidebars.

- Degree of investigative difficulty
- Exclusivity
- Impact of investigation

#### 8. SPORTS REPORTING

This category honors the best single sports story or feature.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- General writing excellence
- Layout excellence
- General photographic excellence (if photos are included)

#### 9. BUSINESS & INDUSTRY REPORTING

This category honors the best news story that focuses on a business, industry or profession.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Degree of reader interest
- Quality of finished product
- Exclusivity or unique angle developed

#### **10. ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT**

This category honors an outstanding single review or feature about arts and entertainment.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- General writing excellence
- Exclusivity of unique angles developed

#### 11. EDITORIAL CARTOON

This category honors the best single editorial cartoon on any issue of public interest. The award is meant to encourage cartoonists to take a stand and express their opinions visually and humorously on issues affecting their communities, state or nation.

#### 24. ONLINE VIDEO

This category honors the best submitted video.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Concerns an issue of reader interest
- Includes interviews, standups and/or voiceovers to enhance the story
- Visuals include a range of long, medium and closeup shots that are well composed, balanced and focused
- Audio is clear
- Graphics are used to identify story elements and/or subjects

#### 25. GENERAL WEBSITE EXCELLENCE

This category honors the best overall website.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Homepage has an appealing balance of text, display, type, photographs and graphics
- Website is easy to navigate, using menus or tabs that work and provide content when clicked
- Content is written and organized for the Web, and provides multimedia approaches and links to additional sites or resources
- A link is provided to PDF version of a print newspaper, and the site is device responsive
- The site provides readers with opportunities to comment, contact information for the site/staff and archives of earlier content

#### 26. SOCIAL MEDIA EXCELLENCE

This category honors the best use of social media.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Quality and originality of content on all social media platforms
- Innovation in using social media in new ways
- Impac
- Engagement with followers, fans and critics

## 27. DIGITAL NEWSLETTER EXCELLENCE

This category honors the best digital newsletter.

- Design is appealing
- Use of graphics
- Quality of all elements (text, headline, graphics)

## PUBLICATION EXCELLENCE

#### 28. DIRECTORIES

This category honors the industry directory that best represents its markets in its overall presentation. Entry must be a standalone product.

- Value to user
- Use of graphics, artwork and supporting editorial
- Completeness of coverage

#### 29. TRADE MAGAZINE

This category honors a trade magazine published specifically for one type of industry.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Overall industry completeness of coverage
- Effective use of artwork and graphic design
- Effective design and layout

#### **30. SPECIAL SECTION EXCELLENCE**

This category honors the best special section.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Degree of reader interest
- Quality of the finished product
- Exclusivity or unique angle developed

#### 31. VISITOR PUBLICATION EXCELLENCE

This category honors a visitor publication that best represents its market in its overall presentation.

#### JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Overall industry completeness of coverage
- Effective use of artwork and graphic design
- Effective design and layout

### 32. NON-DAILY NEWSPAPER EXCELLENCE

This category honors the best weekly, biweekly or monthly newspaper, which serves a local Hawaii community or particular group. Three complete entries of the publication required for entry.

- Quality and completeness of editorial coverage
- Relevance to the community or group it is serving
- Design, layout and photography

This category honors the best video submitted by a college media program.

- Visuals include a range of long, medium and closeup shots that are well composed, balanced and focused
- · Audio is clear
- Graphics are used to identify story elements and/or subjects

#### **36. STUDENT DESIGN (PRINT)**

This category honors the best overall design in print, using all elements of artwork, graphics or photography that make up what the readers see on the page. Entry can be a single editorial story, cover or layout.

- Creativity of subject matter
- Technical quality
- Effectiveness in conveying editorial message

#### **37. STUDENT NEWSPAPER EXCELLENCE**

This category honors a weekly, biweekly, monthly or quarterly newspaper, which serves a Hawaii college. Three complete issues of the publication from the 2016 calendar year are required for entry.
